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Actions Based on Nara Women's University's Activity Index
Established to Prevent the Spread of Novel Coronavirus Disease (Guide on Actions from May 15, 2020)

In response to the release of the emergency state declaration in Nara Prefecture on May 14, actions based on the following phases will be taken for each activity index during Saturday, May 16 to Sunday, May 31, for the time being. However, restrictions in the prefecture may be eased further, going forward, before May 31; some of the guides on actions may be revised, in light of changes in the situation.

The emergency state declaration has been released in Nara Prefecture but not in some of the surrounding prefectures within commuting distance to the university. We ask students to continue behaving in a manner that prioritizes the lives of oneself and also precious others around us.

Index 1 Classes	2	<p>Only remote classes are held</p> <p>- Some classes limited to exercises, experiments, and study sessions will be offered in classroom style, upon taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection (such classes will be notified separately)</p>
Index 2 Researches	2	<p>Entry to campus by undergraduate students</p> <p>- Entry to campus by undergraduate students is prohibited. However, only in cases where such restriction will significantly hinder the progress of their senior research or thesis, undergraduate students may enter the campus, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff and taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection.</p> <p>Entry to campus by graduate students</p> <p>-Entry to campus by graduate students from regions with high numbers of infected people is prohibited. However, if such restriction will significantly hinder the progress of their researches, such graduate students may enter the campus, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff and taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection.</p> <p>-Entry to campus by graduate students from regions with low numbers of infected people is permitted, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff.</p> <p>Research groups in classroom-style gatherings and study sessions are prohibited</p> <p>- Some are permitted if permission from supervising teaching staff is obtained and utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection is taken.</p> <p>Teaching staff may perform research activities, upon taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infections</p>
Index 3 Extracurricular activities	3	All are prohibited
Index 4 Entry to campus	2	<p>Entry to campus by both undergraduate and graduate students</p> <p>- Students are permitted to enter the campus for partial exercises, experiments, and study sessions offered in classroom style, upon taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection.</p> <p>-If students whose dormitories are under construction need to enter the campus to secure a place for online interviews, they may enter the campus upon permission from supervising teaching staff.</p> <p>- If students participating in remote classes need to use school facilities since they cannot secure Internet connection at home, they may enter the campus.</p> <p>-If students want to purchase lunches at the University Co-op (11a.m.-2 p.m. on weekdays) with the store-entry application forms shown at the guard room in advance, they may enter the campus.</p> <p>Entry to campus by undergraduate students</p> <p>- Entry to campus by undergraduate students is prohibited. However, only in cases where such restriction will significantly hinder the progress of their senior research or thesis, undergraduate students may enter the campus, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff and taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection.</p> <p>Entry to campus by graduate students</p> <p>-Entry to campus by graduate students from regions with high numbers of infected people is prohibited. However, if such restriction will significantly hinder the progress of their researches, such graduate students may enter the campus, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff and taking utmost heed to prevent the spread of infection.</p> <p>-Entry to campus by graduate students from regions with low numbers of infected people is permitted, upon receiving permission from supervising teaching staff.</p> <p>Entry to campus by external persons is prohibited</p> <p>-Entry to campus by affiliated persons (vendors) is permitted.</p>

Index 5 Work	3	<p>Off-peak commute and remote work, for operations that allow it, are implemented, upon decisions by the heads of organizations</p> <p><i>-Remote work and off-peak commute are recommended to those who reside in or those whose commute route passes through regions declared to be in emergency state.</i></p> <p><i>-Remote work will be allowed for those who reside in or those whose commuting route passes through regions where local governments continue to request for remote work, even after the release of emergency state declarations, if proper working and security environments are secured at home and managers deem that their performance level can be maintained (as compared to when working on-location).</i></p> <p>As a general rule, business trips are prohibited</p>
Index 6 Meetings	3	<p>Only necessary meetings are held upon taking measures to avoid the three Cs</p> <p>Remote conference systems used as well.</p>
